### **Abrasive Wheel Training**

The Abrasive Wheel Regulations requires people who use machinery with rotating or spinning wheels, plates or flanges to be competent. There is a requirement under the Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 to provide training for your employees.

The aim of this course is to ensure that our trainees are competent to operate equipment containing an abrasive wheel.

By the end of this training course trainees will be able to:

- State their duties and responsibilities under the Health & Safety at Work Act 1974
- Identify any hazards associated with Abrasive Wheels
- Understand the best way to store Abrasive Wheels and the importance of using Blotters
- Understand the importance of following a Safe System of Work while operating an abrasive wheel
- Understand the importance of wearing correct Personal Protective Equipment
- Be able to identify and report any faults, defects or unsafe conditions when using abrasive wheel

The employer will benefit from having trained staff that are less likely to have lost time accidents. The employees will benefit from being able to work safer and more efficiently.
