Disability Discrimination Awareness

This course is aimed at any person wishing to improve their knowledge in relation to issues surrounding disability and discrimination against disabled people.

- Identify what direct disability discrimination is.
- Describe what discrimination arising from disability is.
- Understand what indirect discrimination is.
- Discuss what reasonable adjustments you have to make for disabled people.
- State what Harassment is.
- State what Victimisation is.
- Understand what they need to do to implement their Disability Discrimination Policy
- Demonstrate where to find further sources of advice around the topic.
