Fire Risk Assessment

This course is aimed at anyone who is, or will be, responsible for carrying out periodic fire risk assessments in their place of work.

Under the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005, the responsibility for fire risk assessment in any workplace lies with the accountable 'responsible person'.

Our Fire Risk Assessment course is half a day in duration and will provide the 'responsible person' with a knowledge and understanding of the fire risk assessment process and the skills required to undertake suitable and sufficient fire risk assessments.

The course covers the following topics:

- A background to fire safety legislation

- The principles of fire risk assessment
- Documenting your findings
- Practical fire risk assessments

By the end of the session candidates will be able to:

- Explain the current fire safety legislation
- Understand workplace fire safety issues
- Understand the Fire Risk assessment process
- Confidently carry out a suitable Fire Risk assessment
