



Course Syllabus

Fire Warden

This course is aimed at all company personnel, in particular those with responsibility for fire prevention or those who are required to act as fire marshals in the event of a fire.

The aim of this course is to;

- Provide information regarding the latest fire regulations applicable to the workplace.
- Raise your awareness of fire, how fire develops and how to prevent fires.
- Show how to extinguish fires using the correct extinguishing media.
- Impart the knowledge required to enable the student to carry out evacuation procedures as per company literature.

By the end of the session candidates will be able to:

- Explain the legal framework applicable to fire safety at work.
- Carry out a basic fire risk assessment as per Fire Regulations 2006.
- Explain the theory of combustion and ways of preventing fires.
- Choose and use (if customer has suitable environment) the correct extinguisher on a real fire.
- Explain and simulate escape from a smoke filled room.
- Describe and carry out the correct evacuation procedure as per company literature.
- Explain and demonstrate the responsibilities of a fire warden (as per company policy).
