



Course Syllabus

Level 2 Award in Emergency First Aid in the Workplace

This course is aimed at Appointed Person First Aiders under the Health and Safety First Aid Regulations 1981.

The course is aimed at enabling an appointed person to give emergency aid to a co worker prior to the arrival of emergency medical services.

By the end of the session the candidate will be able to:

- Understand the role of the first-aider including reference to:
- The importance of preventing cross infection
- The need of recording incidents and actions
- Use of available equipment
- Assess the situation and circumstances in order to act safely, promptly and effectively in an emergency
- Administer first aid to a casualty who is unconscious (including seizure)
- Administer cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- Administer first aid to a casualty who is choking
- Administer first aid to a casualty who is wounded and bleeding
- Administer first aid to a casualty who is suffering from shock
- Provide appropriate first aid for minor injuries (including small cuts, grazes and bruises, minor burns and scalds, small splinters).
