### **Noise at Work**

According to the Health & Safety Executive, in excess of one million employees in Great Britain are exposed to levels of noise that put their hearing at risk. Around 75,000 people in the UK suffer from deafness, ringing in the ears or other hearing conditions as a result of excessive noise at work. It is a therefore a legal requirement that anyone who works within areas of excessive noise is appropriately protected and trained.

This course will help to ensure compliance with the Control of Noise at Work Regulations 2005

### **Who Should Take This Noise Awareness Course?**

This course is aimed at employees of all levels, including managers, supervisors, workers and contractors; in fact anyone who may be exposed to noise in the workplace. This includes, but is not limited to, industries such as Construction, Manufacturing, Mining,

It is also suitable for any workers with the responsibility of carrying out a noise risk assessment for their organisation.

Do You Comply With Control of Noise at Work Regulations 2005?

It is a legal requirement that all workers who are exposed to noise at work should receive suitable health and safety training.

The Control of Noise at Work Regulations 2005 state that all organisations have a duty of care to protect their employees. Self-employed workers also have a duty to protect themselves and any other persons at work who may be affected by noise in the workplace.

Regulation 10 of the Control of Noise at Work Regulations states that employers must provide information, instruction and training to any employee who is exposed to noise at or above the lower exposure action values; this training must cover noise exposure limits, detecting noise and safe working practices to reduce exposure to noise. This course ensures that you comply with this regulation.
